### Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots

#### Key vocabulary/glossary

Scots	The tribe that lived in Ireland and western Scotland when the Romans left
Picts	The tribe that lived on the eastern side of the Scottish mountains at the same time
Anglo - Saxons	People from Germanic tribes, central Europe who settled here in the 5th century.
English Language	Origin Over half of the words we use today are Anglo Saxon.
Invaders	The people who arrived, stole and returned home.

Roman withdrawal from Britain in c. AD 410  
The Britons had to adjust to the Romans leaving and invasions from other people.



Scots invasions from Ireland to north Britain (now Scotland.)
