Important Update on School Re-opening and Swimming Pool Facilities

Dear Pupils, Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you and your families well. We are delighted to announce that our school, which was temporarily closed, will be re-opening its doors to all pupils from Wednesday, 24th September 2025. The staff and I are looking forward to welcoming everyone back and resuming our usual school activities.

We would like to extend our sincere thanks for your patience and understanding during the recent closure. Your support has been greatly appreciated and has helped us ensure that the necessary preparations and safety measures are in place for a smooth re-opening.

However, we wish to inform you of an important update regarding our swimming pool facilities. Due to continuing re-roofing work, the swimming pool will close from Monday 29th September 2025. It will remain closed for two weeks so we can ensure we get the water quality right, after the work. We anticipate that it will be fully operational and ready for use from Tuesday, 14th October 2025. In the meantime, all swimming lessons and pool activities will temporarily be suspended. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and thank you for your understanding as we work to maintain the highest standards of safety for all users.

The roof work above the pool will involve turning off the boilers, so some areas of the school may be cool, and we will be advising if the pupils require additional layers.

We are committed to keeping you informed and will provide further updates should there be any changes to this schedule. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact your child/young person's Key Worker or the School Office, using your usual communication systems.

Thank you once again for your continued support. We look forward to seeing our pupils back in school and to a successful and enjoyable rest of term.
