### Amazing first achievements in medicine

**John Snow, 1813-1858**

the first doctor to show that disease could be waterborne by his investigation of the Broad Street pump. This hailed the beginning of the end of cholera in the UK.



**Edward Jenner**

made the first successful vaccine to help eradicate

Local pilot, Ray Holmes from Wallasey shot down a German Dornier plane that was heading for Buckingham Palace.

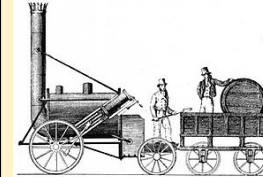
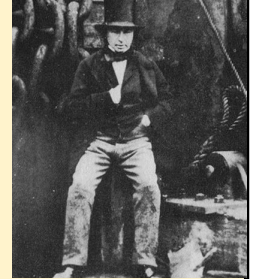


### Amazing first achievements in engineering

**Isambard Kingdom Brunel**

1808-1859

built the first railway from London to Bristol and built the Clifton Suspension Bridge, pioneering long distance railway travel.

1772-1850
